

To enhance services to the Grant County citizens, the E-911 Board has established the Grant County Emergency Notification system which will be implemented in the next 30 days. This system was designed to supplement our existing weather sirens in the event of a weather emergency. In partnership with the E-911 Board the Kentucky State Police Post can activate the new call system to notify our citizens of a **TORNADO WARNING**

Accessing the web site listed below, the system **may also** notify individuals using the following additional methods;

- Cell Phone - Calling and playing a message on your cell phone
- Email - Sending an email to one or more email accounts.
- Text Message - Sending a message to wireless devices.

Using the E-911 Database all business and home phone numbers have already been automatically added. However, as a citizen of Grant County you may choose to enhance this service by creating a new account, and adding additional contact information by subscribing to the citizen group on the web site listed below. On this site you may then add cell phone numbers, email addresses and text message addresses, and an emergency notification will be sent to all.

This is a new service being introduced to Grant County, so please know that we will be **performing test calls** on _____ to test the system. Until the actual event of an emergency and call, please pay attention to changing weather conditions and be prepared to take shelter when severe weather approaches and use a weather radio or portable radio to get up to date weather information.

How to add contact numbers and email addresses:

1. Go to www.grantcounty.ky.gov scroll down to GC Emergency Management notification and click on the link provided.
2. Click **NEW ACCOUNT** in the right corner
3. Fill out information and remember, Blue fields must be filled in to continue
4. Create an 8 character login and 8 character password
5. Include your email address and agree **TO THE** Terms by typing **YES** in box then agree to privacy policy by typing **yes** in box then hit green create box
6. You will now be redirected to the **Login** screen.
7. Click log in and you will be prompted for the login and password that you created in step 4.
8. Go to **USER** tab located in the left corner
9. Click **SUBSCRIPTIONS** this will show you the option of **CITIZEN** group which is what you want
10. Chose **CITIZENS** by clicking in the box and hit **SUBSCRIBE** button
11. Then go to **USER** tab again
12. Click on **CONTACT**
13. **Choose a method of contact, fill in your information and save.**
14. To add additional contact numbers and/or email address repeat steps 11 and 12
