





Open Discussion for “Good of the County”

Rusty Willoughby asked if the audit had started at the Jail and Judge Link stated that it has not as the remaining staff has had some problems obtaining all the information that is necessary. All the people who were in positions of authority are no longer with the Jail and things are in disarray and it is a challenge to gather the information necessary to begin the audit. Mr. Willoughby questioned whether or not Mr. Hankins could be appointed to Jailer and Judge Link stated that he could not. Judge Link had considered appointing Mr. Hankins in another role but with Mr. Peebles still serving as Jailer, that would be unfair to Mr. Hankins, as the current jailer could undermine anything that Mr. Hankins implemented.

Mr. Willoughby then thanked Judge Link and the court for all their help for the Corinth Fire Department in the past.

Sheriff Chuck Dills stated that once again parts of the old DES building were stolen from the Willoby property, but that the sheriff’s department had caught the persons responsible and had the building parts moved to the county barn for protection against further thefts.

Magistrate Hammons stated that once again, the Road department did a great job with snow removal on our roads. She also stated that the three magistrates had traveled to Louisville to be presented with a plaque for Certification for Grant County being a Work Ready Community in Progress. We are now certified by the Kentucky Workforce Investment Board. Ron Livingood was present at the ceremony as well. Both Williamstown High School and Grant County High School are in the program.
