



Grant County Fiscal Court
Regular Meeting Minutes
April 19, 2022
6:30 P.M. via Video Conference

The Grant County Fiscal Court met in regular session on Tuesday, April 19, 2022 at 6:30P.M. on zoom via video conference in Williamstown, Kentucky. Those in attendance include the Honorable Judge/Executive Chuck Dills, Magistrate Shawna Coldiron, Magistrate Jacquelyn Riley, Magistrate Roger Humphrey, County Attorney Stephen Bates II, Fiscal Court Clerk Jenna Johnson and Deputy Judge/Executive Colton Simpson.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to approve the regular meeting minutes of April 5, 2022. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Humphrey to approve all claims drawn in the general fund, road fund, and jail fund along with all transfers presented dated April 19, 2022. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Riley and seconded by Magistrate Humphrey to approve the Resolution 2022-02 relating to the Grant County Fiscal Court setting the salary of the County Attorney for the new term of office commencing on January 2, 2023. All in favor, motion carried.

The court approved the recommendations of the bid committee of materials and supplies for the Grant County Road Department as advertised for Fiscal Year 2022-2023.

Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Riley to approve the lowest and best bid for Stone was awarded to Crupper Transport based on his bid including transportation fee. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Riley to approve the best bid for Salt was awarded to Crupper Transport based on past service, less than 24-hour delivery and a local vendor. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Riley to approve the lowest fuel cost which is submitted daily. The court voted to check for daily pricing on the lowest cost. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to approve the bid for Hot Mix Asphalt, which was awarded to Riegler. Cold Mix Asphalt was awarded to Eaton Asphalt as they were the only bids. All in favor, motion carried.

The court approved the recommendations of the bid committee of security cameras for the Grant County Detention Center as advertised for Fiscal Year 2022-2023. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to approve the best and lowest bid, which was awarded to LiveView. All in favor, motion carried.

Judge/Executive Chuck Dills asked the audience if they wished to address the court, and there being none, a motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Humphrey to adjourn. Judge/Executive Dills reminded the court that the next meeting will be held Tuesday, May 3, 2022 at 6:30 P.M at the Courthouse. All in favor, motion carried.
