The Grant County Fiscal Court met in regular session on Tuesday, August 16, 2022 at 6:30 PM on zoom via video conference in Williamstown, Kentucky. Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to approve the regular meeting minutes of August 02, 2022. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Riley to accept Patrick Goodman, Grant County Public Library Tax Rate for Fiscal Year 2022-2023. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Riley to change Thomas McDaniel employment from Part Time to Full Time Position for Animal Shelter Laborer, effective August 15, 2022. All in favor, motion carried.
