



Grant County Fiscal Court
Regular Meeting Minutes
June 6, 2023 @ 4:30 P.M.

The Grant County Fiscal Court met in regular session on Tuesday, June 6, 2023, at 4:30 P.M. at the Courthouse in Williamstown, Kentucky. Those in attendance include the Honorable Judge/Executive Chuck Dills, Magistrate Jacquelyn Riley via Zoom, Magistrate Shawna Coldiron, Magistrate Roger Humphrey, Judge Stephen Bates in place of County Attorney Stephen L. Bates II, Deputy Judge/Executive Colton Simpson, and Fiscal Court Clerk Jenna Johnson. Guest Jason Frilling.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to approve the regular meeting minutes of May 17, 2023 and special meeting minutes of May 19, 2023. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Riley to approve all claims on the general fund, road fund, and jail fund, along with all transfers presented dated June 06, 2023. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Riley to approve the salaries for employees of the Grant County Fiscal Court, along with the Road Department, Sheriff's Office and the Detention Center. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Riley to approve the Standing Order to pre-approve certain recurring expense to wit: Payroll, Utilities, Insurance Premiums, Payments to Election Officers, Election Commissioners and County Clerk Storage Fees. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Riley and seconded by Magistrate Humphrey to approve Resolution 2023-10 and to sign the agreement between Department of Transportation and Grant County regarding Turner Road Bridge. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Riley to accept George Moore, Grant County Local Board of Health Tax Rate for Year 2023. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to approve Resolution 2023-09, Grant County Sanitary Sewer District Regional Facilities Plan. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Riley to approve the re-appointment of Mike Drysdale, Kenton County Airport Board, active on July 1, 2023 and to expire on June 30, 2027. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Riley and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to approve Monnie Leap to prepare the Sheriff's 2022 Tax Settlement. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Humphrey to approve the re-appointment of Peggy Updike as Grant County Treasurer for four-year term. All in favor, motion carried.

First reading on Ordinance No. 0007-2023-0264 regarding the amendment to the Administrative Code. This is for review only, no action required.

Motion was made by Magistrate Riley and seconded by Magistrate Humphrey to approve the Second Reading of Ordinance No. 0006-2023-0263, to amend the Zoning Ordinance regarding the section on fences. All in favor, motion carried.

Reports were presented from Treasurer, Animal Shelter, Road Supervisor, Building Inspector, Coroner, Jailer, Sheriff, Judge/Executive Chuck Dills, Magistrate Riley, Magistrate Coldiron, and Magistrate Humphrey. These reports are for review only and no action is required.

Judge/Executive Chuck Dills asked the audience if they wished to address the court. There being none, a motion was made by Magistrate Riley and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to adjourn.
