The Grant County Fiscal Court met in regular session on Wednesday, May 17, 2023 at 4:30 PM on zoom via video conference in Williamstown, Kentucky. Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Humphrey to approve the regular meeting minutes of May 02, 2023. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Riley to approve all claims on the general fund, road fund, jail fund, and ARPA fund, along with all transfers presented dated May 17, 2023. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Riley to approve the appointment of Matt Morgan, Re-Apportionment Board, District 3. All in favor, motion carried.
