Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to approve the regular meeting minutes of July 18, 2023. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Riley to approve the Second Reading on Ordinance No. 0008-2023-0265 for the re-apportionment of the magisterial lines. All in favor, motion carried.
