Regular Meeting Minutes

The Grant County Fiscal Court met in regular session on Tuesday, April 02, 2024, at 4:30 P.M. at the Courthouse in Williamstown, Kentucky. Those in attendance include the Honorable Judge/Executive Chuck Dills, Magistrate Jacquelyn Riley, Magistrate Shawna Coldiron, Magistrate Roger Humphrey via Zoom, County Attorney Stephen Bates II, and Fiscal Court Clerk Jenna Johnson. Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Riley to approve regular meeting minutes of March 19, 2024. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Riley to approve all claims on the general fund, road fund, jail fund, and opioid settlement fund along with all transfers presented dated April 02, 2024. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Riley to approve and allow the Judge/Executive to sign the EMS Interlocal Agreement with the City of Dry Ridge. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Riley to approve the Resolution 2024-03, Hazard Mitigation Plan. All in favor, motion carried.
