



Grant County Fiscal Court  
Special Meeting Minutes  
November 19, 2024 @ 5:00 P.M.

The Grant County Fiscal Court met in special session on Tuesday, November 19, 2024, at 5:00 P.M. at the courthouse in Williamstown, Kentucky. Those in attendance include the Honorable Judge/Executive Chuck Dills, Magistrate Jacquelyn Riley, Magistrate Shawna Coldiron via zoom, Magistrate Roger Humphrey, Assistant County Attorney Pete Whaley, Deputy Judge/Executive Colton Simpson, and Fiscal Court Clerk Jenna Johnson. Guest Tony Morgan.

Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Humphrey to approve the regular meeting minutes of November 04, 2024, special meeting minutes of November 08, 2024 and special meeting minutes of November 12, 2024. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Riley and seconded by Magistrate Humphrey to approve all claims on the general fund, road fund, and jail fund along with all transfers presented dated November 19, 2024. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to appoint Todd Tallon, Road Department Laborer, effective December 09, 2024. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Riley and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to approve accept bids on the transport vehicle for the Grant County Detention Center. This will be paid for by the Opioid Settlement Fund. Judge Dills, Magistrate Riley, Magistrate Coldiron in favor and Magistrate Humphrey opposed, motion carried.

Judge/Executive Chuck Dills asked the audience if they wished to address the court, and there being none, a motion was made by Magistrate Riley and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to adjourn. Judge/Executive Chuck Dills reminded the Court that the next meeting of this body will be held on Tuesday, December 03, 2024, or until the call of the chair. All in favor, motion carried.
