

The Grant County Fiscal Court met in regular session on Tuesday, May 20, 2025, at 6:00 P.M. at the courthouse in Williamstown, Kentucky. Motion was made by Magistrate Riley and seconded by Magistrate Humphrey to approve the special meeting minutes of May 06, 2025. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Riley and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to approve all claims on the general fund, road fund and jail fund, along with all transfers presented dated May 20, 2025. Magistrate Humphrey opposed; motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to appoint Eric Walters, Grant County Planning and Zoning Commission, effective May 20, 2025 and to expire October 31, 2027. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Riley to approve the Grant County Road Department Surplus list. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to approve Monnie Leap to prepare the Sheriff's 2024 Tax Settlement. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Riley to accept the Grant County Local Board of Health Tax Rate for Fiscal Year 2025-2026. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Humphrey to approve Ordinance No. 0003-2025-0286, Mark & Judy Shepperd Zone Change. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Riley to approve Ordinance No. 0004-2025-0287, Leisa Shipp Zone Change. All in favor, motion carried.

First Reading on Ordinance No. 0005-2025-0288, Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Budget. Review only.
