



Grant County Fiscal Court
Regular Meeting Minutes
April 07, 2026 @ 6:00pm.

The Grant County Fiscal Court met in regular session on Tuesday, April 07, 2026, at 6:00pm at the courthouse in Williamstown, Kentucky. Those in attendance include the Honorable Judge/Executive Chuck Dills via Zoom, Magistrate Jacquelyn Riley, Magistrate Shawna Coldiron, Magistrate Roger Humphrey, Assistant County Attorney Pete Whaley and Fiscal Court Clerk Jenna Alsip. Guest were Jeremy Lilly, David Rose, Josh Brearton, Tonya Beagle, Debby Lucas Angel.

Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Humphrey to approve the regular meeting minutes of March 17, 2026 and special meeting minutes of March 26, 2026. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Riley to approve all claims on the general fund, road fund, and jail fund, along with all transfers presented dated April 07, 2026. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Riley and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to approve the revisions made to the Grant County Detention Center's Policy and Procedures Manual, per 501 KAR 3:020 Section 1. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to approve the re-appointment of Mike Duley, Grant County Sanitary Sewer District, retroactive February 21, 2026 and to expire February 20, 2030. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Riley to approve the appointment of Tammi Jackson, Part-Time to Full-Time Building Inspector Assistant, retroactive April 01, 2026. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to approve the appointment of Shelly McCoy, Assistant County Treasurer, effective April 20, 2026. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Riley and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to approve the addition to the Standing Order: County Treasurer Assistant Salary. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to approve Resolution 2026-02 to begin proceedings under KRS Chapter 178 to discontinue a portion of a county road known as Lake Road (041 CR-1055B). All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Riley to approve the re-appointment of Joe Gordon, Grant County Road Supervisor, Gary Bowling, and Carl Jackson Jr. to serve as the committee to prepare a report in regards to the proposed discontinuance of a portion of 041 CR-1055B, known as Lake Road. All in favor, motion carried.

New Business regarding the Fair Housing Month Proclamation 2026 and Arbor Day Proclamation 2026.
