Regular Meeting Minutes

The Grant County Fiscal Court met in regular session on Tuesday, May 05, 2026, at 6:00pm at the courthouse in Williamstown, Kentucky. Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Humphrey to approve the regular meeting minutes of April 21, 2026 and special meeting minutes of April 27, 2026. All in favor, motion carried.
