Regular Meeting Minutes
July 21, 2026 @ 6:00pm

The Grant County Fiscal Court met in regular session on Tuesday, July 21, 2026, at 6:00pm at the courthouse in Williamstown, Kentucky. Those in attendance include the Honorable Judge/Executive Chuck Dills, Magistrate Jacquelyn Riley, Magistrate Shawna Coldiron, Magistrate Roger Humphrey, Assistant County Attorney Pete Whaley, and Fiscal Court Clerk Jenna Alsip. Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Humphrey to approve regular meeting minutes of July 07, 2026. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Riley to approve all claims on the general fund, road fund and jail fund, along with all transfers presented dated July 21, 2026. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to re-appointment of Steve Moerlein, Grant County Board of Adjustments, retroactive to February 01, 2026 and to expire January 31, 2029. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Humphrey to approve the re-appointment of Sam McComas, Grant County Board of Adjustments, retroactive to February 01, 2026 and to expire January 31, 2029. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Riley and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to approve the re-appointment of Melissa Wallace, Grant County Public Library Board, retroactive to February 21, 2026 and to expire February 20, 2029. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Riley to approve the re-appointment of Jamie Baker, Grant County Public Library Board, retroactive to July 01, 2026 and to expire June 30, 2030. Magistrate Humphrey voted no. Magistrate Coldiron, Magistrate Riley and Judge Executive Chuck Dills voted yes, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Riley and seconded by Magistrate Humphrey to approve the re-appointment of Patricia "Pat" Conrad, NKADD Council of Aging, retroactive to July 01, 2026 and to expire June 30, 2030. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to approve the appointment of James Williams, Full-Time Grant County Animal Shelter Laborer, retroactive July 13, 2026. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Riley and seconded by Magistrate Humphrey to approve the appointment of Keisha Mitts, Assistant County Treasurer, effective August 01, 2026. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to approve Resolution 2026-06, Bridge Repair/Replacement CCBIP (FD15) Funds \$689,185, and allow Chuck Dills to sign said agreement. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Humphrey and seconded by Magistrate Riley to approve the recommendations of the bid committee for the Grant County Road Department, (9) roads for bid. Mago Construction was awarded the bid. Please refer to the bid committee minutes for specifications on pricing. All in favor, motion carried.

Judge/Executive Chuck Dills asked the audience if they wished to address the court, then a motion was made by Magistrate Riley and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to adjourn.
